#### SUMMARY

This bibliography includes 680 references of documents on tropical agroforestry. Most of the documents deal with the American tropics, but there are also documents from Africa, Asia and Oceania. Two indices are presented, one by authors, and the other combining subjects, species and countries, including 363 authors, 94 subject key words, 57 geographical terms and 71 botanical genera. Instructions are given on the use of the bibliography, how to consult the documents and how to obtain (by mail) copies of these papers.

### RESUMEN

Se incluyen 680 referencias bibliográficas de documentos relacionados con agroforestería tropical. En su mayoría los documentos se refieren al trópico americano, pero también los hay de Africa, Asia y Oceanía. Se presentan dos índices, uno de autores y otro en el que se combinan temas agroforestales, especies y países. Se incluyen 363 autores, 94 palabras claves de temas, 57 términos geográficos y 71 géneros de especies vegetales. Se ofre cen instrucciones para el uso de la bibliografía, para consultar los documentos agroforestales incluidos y para obtener por correo fotocopias de los mismos.

#### PRESENTATION

#### WHY AND HOW WAS THIS WORK INITIATED

Between 1977 and 1979 Mr. Jean Combe, a Swiss forestry expert assigned to CATIE by the Swiss Program of Cooperation for Development, DDA, collected and classified approximately 380 bibliographical references - and most of the respective supporting documents - on tropical agroforestry.

The collection of documents was initiated in July, 1977, and they served as the basis for studies on classification and investigation on agroforestry techniques (see references No. 11397, 11697, 11753, 11754, 11884, 11885). Later, the collection was oriented toward the study of particular techniques, reports on successful applications, and a few reports on ongoing research. The acquired information permitted the design of various field experiments allowing the quantification of the most interesting techniques both on CATIE grounds and on small farms in the Turrialba region (see references No. 11777 and 11908).

Publication on research methods on specific aspects were later introduced. Among these publications special notice should be made of "Expert Consultation on Soils Research in Agroforestry", ICRAF (see references No. 11843 to 11875). These materials, together with their preliminary classification as compiled by Combe, were the nucleus of the present bibliography.

Mr. Combe returned to Switzerland in March, 1980, after a very successful job in CATIE. His documentation work was continued by Mr. Humberto Jiménez Saa, M.S., a professional forester, in collaboration with Miss Claudia Monge, B.S., Miss Gerardina Araya and Mr. Gilberto Gamboa, employees of INFORAT (Información y Documentación Forestal para América Tropical), a project promoting forest information and documentation, sponsored by DDA.

The original collection continued growing: bibliographical references were composed, missing documents were obtained, key words were assigned to each of the documents, a Uniterm card system was introduced and the information was partially stored in discs to be processed by the computer center at CATIE. Finally the present bibliography was compiled.

#### WHAT WE OFFER THE USER

In the present bibliography 680 references are included, covering a great number of subjects. In regard to geographical distribution, emphasis was on Tropical America, but references on Africa, Asia, Australia and New Zealand are also included. There is no pretense to cover everything that has been published in the field of Agroforestry; on the contrary, in some cases only representative works have been included, with the hope that they will facilitate a detailed complementary search.

With regard to the quality of the subject matter included, the criteria for selection was not rigorous. It is expected that a more exclusive selection will be made in the future, when experience will allow more solidly defined selection guidelines.

#### A DOCUMENTATION CENTER ON AGROFORESTRY

All documents included herewith are located in the INFORAT office, within the Natural Renewable Resources Program at CATIE in Turrialba.

In summary, what started with a document collection, developed into a bibliography and finally became a Documentation Center on Tropical Agroforestry, with the objective of making the documents available to all who require them. Users will greatly benefit by reading the instructions on pages 40-49.

#### WHO COOPERATED

As can be noticed, the compiling of this bibliography and the structuring of the Documentation Center involved the concourse of several persons. The initial collection and classification of the first 380 references and the acquisition of a good amount of the respective documents was done by Jean Combe. The acquisition of new documents, the composing of their bibliographical references and the ordering in card files and shelves has been the work of Claudia Monge, with the collaboration of Gerardina Araya and Gilberto Gamboa. Mr. Eduardo Escalante, M.S., a CATIE graduate student of Agroforestry, cooperated enthusiastically providing documents that were added to the collection.

The implementation of a specialized vocabulary, analysis and indexing of the documents, the storing of the information in manual and in automatic systems, the editing of the final publication, and the direction and coordination, has been the work of Mr. Humberto Jiménez Saa. Translation of the present English version was done by Mrs. Vera Fernández.

On my part, as a specialist on Agroforestry subjects and as leader of the Work Group S1.07-07 of the International Union of Forestry Research Organization, IUFRO, I receive almost on a permanent basis an appreciable amount of documents on agroforestry that are automatically at the disposal of INFORAT, to be included in the bibliographical collection. The Documentation Center on Tropical Agroforestry has received the support of CATIE and of numerous entities and persons who have kindly shown their satisfaction and support. It is our hope that besides being an efficient mechanism to diffuse information, a documentation center such as ours will constitute a model that can be transfered to other professional groups interested in implementing and diffusing specialized and short documental collections.

#### THERE IS A LONG ROAD AHEAD

Obviously, the work is not finished. Improvement of the collection is under way and it is hoped that a second edition of this bibliography, including summaries and/or abstracts of the documents will be published. Any suggestions or criticisms about omissions, any corrections or notice of failures will be most welcome and will receive due credit in future editions. We hope that this tool will be useful to those who work - or wish to enter - in the field of Agroforestry and related subjects.


